## 2010 Election Timeline

**Tuesday, January 5, 2010**



Notification of Positions & Nomination Forms sent out to members and put on website.

- **Secretary/Treasurer** (Currently held by *Jan Olmstead* who is eligible to run again.)
- **2 Senior High Board Seats** (Currently held by *Julia Doerr* who is ineligible to run again and *John Heineman* who is eligible to run again.)
- **2 Elementary Board Seats** (Currently held by *Linda Freye* who is ineligible to run again and *Tammy Schafer* who is eligible to run again.)
- **Up to 44 NSEA Delegate Assembly Delegates** (*Jenni Absalon, Marcia Benner, and John Heineman* attend as NSEA Board members and are not on the LEA ballot nor as part of the official LEA delegation. The LEA Secretary-Treasurer (to be elected) is an official LEA Delegate and up to 44 more Delegates will be elected)
- **Up to 14 NEA Representative Assembly Delegates** (number to be confirmed by NEA; *Jenni Absalon, Marcia Benner, and John Heineman* attend as NSEA Board members and are not on the LEA ballot nor as part of the official LEA delegation. The LEA Secretary-Treasurer (to be elected) is an official LEA Delegate and up to 14 more Delegates will be elected)

**Thursday, January 21, 2010**

Deadline for Candidates to submit their names and nomination form(s) to the LEA Office to have their names included on the Preliminary Slate.  
FR Council approves by-law changes to be put to vote of membership.

**Friday, January 22, 2010**

Preliminary Slate sent to buildings for posting and sent by email to all members 10 days before FR Council immediately preceding election. Post additional nominated candidates to website within 24 hours of receiving nomination forms.

**Thursday, February 11, 2010**

Candidate filing deadline w/nomination form, 50 word position statement, and resume of Association activities for Board positions; nomination form for NSEA Delegate Assembly positions; and nomination form & statement citing reason for running for RA positions due in the LEA Office by 4:30 P.M.

**Friday, February 12, 2010**

Announcement of electronic voting for candidates and by-law changes sent out to buildings 10 days before voting. Send poster to FRs to post.

**Thursday, February 18, 2010**

FR Council nominations are taken from the floor. Council approves the Final Slate. Drawing for the order of Candidate names on the ballot is done after Council approval.

**Monday, February 22, 2010**

Signatures, electronic or in person, for acceptance of nominations from the floor of FR Council must be received within 2 working days (**by 4:30 P.M.**) at the LEA Office.

**Tuesday, February 23, 2010**

**Final** Slate sent out to buildings to post before election.  
Special Elections Issue of the *LEAdvocate* by email.

**February 24 through  
March 10, 2010**

Electronic voting for both LEA and NSEA. Balloting will begin at 4 p.m. on February 24, 2010 and will end at midnight on March 10, 2010.

**Thursday, March 11, 2010**

LEA Elections Chair or designee and one committee member meet to review and verify electronic voting results within 2 working days.

**Monday, March 15, 2010**

LEA Board takes official action on the results of the election. Candidates for Board Seats are informed of results.

**Tuesday, March 16, 2010**

LEA Board and Delegates for Delegate Assembly and RA informed of election results via e-mail at their schools within 5 working days. Printed results mailed to those without e-mail.

**Thursday, March 18, 2010**
